

# Westfälische Stochastiktage - practical information

## Location

- The workshop will take place in room J2.220 (building J, level 2) on the main campus of Paderborn university.
- We have linked the campus map on our homepage. You can also find information there on how to get to the campus by car or public transportation. The bus stops near our campus are indicated on the campus map.
- If you use public transportation, please note that during the workshop the buses will be running on an emergency timetable: The bus line 100 will be unavailable; instead you may use the lines 1,4 or 6 or one of the regional bus lines. In order to get from the main station to the campus, it is best to use one of the buses. Lines 1,4 and 6 leave from the bus station C at the main train station, which you will find on your right after exiting the train station. If you arrive in Paderborn at the station 'Kasseler Tor' you can easily reach the campus by bus or on foot.
- If you come to us by car, you may use free parking on campus. During the term break usually there are sufficiently many parking spots available.
- Walking from the main station to the campus takes about 40 minutes, from the station 'Kasseler Tor' to the campus about 20 minutes, and from the city center to the campus about 30 minutes.

## Accommodation

- The talks are scheduled so that it should be possible for all participants to arrive before the first talk in the morning of September 19 and to leave after the last talk on September 20. There are various inexpensive options for accommodation for the night of September 19/20, e.g.:

## Talks

- In J2.220 a projector and two blackboards can be used for the talks.
- If you give a presentation by laptop, you may either bring your own laptop - the projector can be used via VGA/HDMI connections - or use our laptop. In the latter case you can bring you talk on a USB drive or send us the talk beforehand by email.

## **Breaks and social event**

- In the breaks coffee, tea and other drinks will be available.
- For lunch we can go to our mensa. In the mensa you can pay by EC-card or credit card - payment by cash is not possible.
- On Thursday evening we can go from campus to the city center and have dinner (outside if the weather permits) and get together afterwards.
