# Location

- The workshop will take place in room J2.213 (building J, level 2) on the main campus of Paderborn university.
- We have linked the campus map on our homepage. You can also find information there on how to get to the campus by car or public transportation. The bus stops near our campus are indicated on the campus map.
- If you use public transportation, please note that Paderborn main station is undergoing construction work. Depending on which direction you come from there may be delays and/or sometimes trains are replaced by buses. In order to get from the main station to the campus it is best to use one of the buses. Please note that the UNI line is not available at the moment. If you arrive in Paderborn at the station 'Kasseler Tor' you can easily get to the campus by bus or on foot.
- If you come to us by car, you may use free parking on campus. During the term break usually there are sufficiently many parking spots available.
- Walking from the main station to the campus takes about 40 minutes, from the station 'Kasseler Tor' to the campus about 20 minutes, and from the city center to the campus about 30 minutes.

## Accomodation

- The talks are scheduled so that it should be possible for all participants to arrive before the first talk in the morning of August 18 and to leave after the last talk on August 19. There are various inexpensive options for accommodation for the night of August 18/19, e.g.:

# **Talks**
